



COVID-19 Vaccine Information for School Districts

As educators and child-care providers, your work is foundational to the well-being of all communities. Because your work is so critical, we're here to support your total health 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. We are honored to support our educators in the community by being your COVID-19 vaccine provider.

Here are some details about what you can expect:

- Kaiser Permanente is offering exclusive weekend appointments for Pre-K-12 educators.
- We are committed to providing an equitable distribution of appointments for educators and school district employees.
- As of Feb. 8, Kaiser Permanente will begin vaccinating educators and child-care providers as outlined by the State of Colorado.
- No single district will receive preference over another.

Invitation to schedule a vaccine appointment at Kaiser Permanente:

Current Kaiser Permanente Members

- Kaiser Permanente will invite you via email, text, or letter to schedule your COVID-19 vaccine appointment when it's your turn and vaccine supply is available.
- Once you receive your invitation, you can schedule your appointment through kp.org or by calling **720-787-3728**.

If you are not a Kaiser Permanente Member

- You will receive an email from Kaiser Permanente with information about your Health Record Number (HRN).
- Use this HRN to register for a secure Kaiser Permanente account at kp.org/register. This will help to make scheduling your vaccine appointment more convenient.
- Once registered on kp.org, watch for your invite via email, text, or letter to schedule your COVID-19 vaccine appointment on a Saturday or Sunday when vaccine supply is available, and it's your turn.

Special Note: We may reach out to some educators to collect additional information that will allow us to assign you a health record number.

How long before I can be vaccinated?

We continue to work to ensure everybody who wants a vaccine can get one as quickly as possible. The State of Colorado has a goal to vaccinate all educators and child-care providers by the end of February, and Kaiser Permanente is committed to supporting this goal. This timeline is dependent on vaccine availability.

What to expect when you get your COVID-19 vaccine

- **Receiving a vaccination card.** When you get your first dose, you'll be given a card that describes the brand of COVID-19 vaccine. This will serve as proof of vaccination, so keep it in a safe place (consider taking a picture of the card as an extra safety measure). You will need to bring this card with you when you receive your second dose.
- **Scheduling for your 2nd dose.** Both federally approved COVID-19 vaccines require 2 doses. The doses are given a few weeks apart, and the same authorized vaccine manufacturer must be used for both doses. We will schedule an appointment for your second dose at the time of your first dose.
