 - o 8 sites have been identified for track and field updates
 - o Construction started at Arvada-Phase I (third floor renovation) completion in 1/2020
 - o Groundbreaking for Kendrick Lakes-Dec. 17; Roche was selected as the contractor
 - o Three Creeks-open by fall 2020

General Update-Construction Mgmt. now has a full team. All positions have been hired.
